



## Correction: Recent trends in the structural revision of natural products

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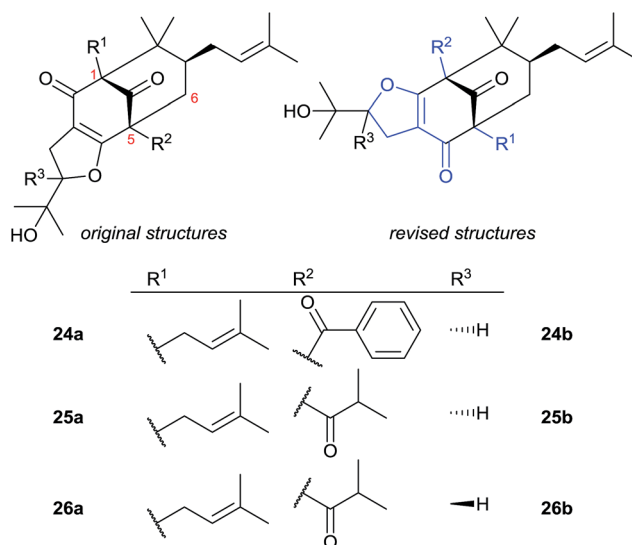
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Correction for 'Recent trends in the structural revision of natural products' by Bhuwan Khatri Chhetri *et al.*, *Nat. Prod. Rep.*, 2018, 35, 514–531.

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The authors regret that, upon further examination, the structure for **24b** depicted in the article is incorrect. It was wrongly inferred that the true structure was the one shown in the supplementary information of ref. 68, which differed from the main text of the same paper. Instead, the correct structure is the structure within the main text of ref. 68, which is also shown below, with an  $\alpha$ -H at the R<sup>3</sup> position. This makes this compound identical to propolone C,<sup>1</sup> as reported in ref. 68. The use of the wrong structure in the computation of NMR properties in ref. 68 was not consequential to the determination of the final structure.

The corrected graphic is shown below:
